Field Shoot 2: Venice Beach / Venice Canals

- I. We are taking University vans on this trip.
 - A. Meet at 8:30 am in front of the Public Safety office. Bring everything you'll need for the day, including money to buy lunch/snacks.
 - B. We will drive to Venice Beach, where we'll meet Tommi Cahill, our guide for the day. She will orient us, give us a sense of where we might find different things, and turn us loose to find them.
 - As we did last time, work in pairs.
 - Both shoot, but think, plan, and observe together.
 - You'll still do an individual meso-PechaKucha presentation (15 slides). You should, however, help each other find things to shoot. You may also help each other develop your presentations.
